## Focus for Pupil Premium Spending 2017/2018

#### We will:

- provide an increased range of workshops for parents to help them support the learning of their children including skills sessions and curriculum updates.
- provide family support work. Supporting parents in overcoming barriers to children's learning. Targeted family work, provision of family learning opportunities and focus on improving attendance and punctuality.
- provide targeted interventions in reading, writing and mathematics to ensure that all pupil premium children, including those with other additional needs, make expected progress and a majority making accelerated progress.
- work towards narrowing the gap between attainment of pupil premium and attainment non-pupil premium children across the curriculum.
- provide a comprehensive programme of training for all staff, including developing middle leaders, which will ensure that teaching and learning is at least good throughout the school.
- develop children's problem solving skills and in order for a higher number of children to achieve greater depth.
- develop the level of resilience in our children so that they become confident learners and achieve the best they can.

### Nature of Support 2017/2018

### Support for children eligible for the grant:

- additional small group or 1:1 intervention delivered by TA/experienced teacher to accelerate learning in reading, writing and mathematics
- access to 1:1/small group support from a qualified counsellor for those with additional emotional/behavioural needs
- small group support for children to engage in resilience building activities

## Funding of:

- resources to plan and deliver effective parental workshops
- resources to deliver a range of intervention programmes to accelerate progress in reading, writing and maths for PPG pupils
- software packages and licences
- CPD on the quality of teaching and learning, to include the Outstanding Teaching Assistant Programme and developing middle leaders

### Part funding of:

a dedicated family support worker

- an educational psychologist and specialist SEN teacher
  2 additional teachers to support reading, writing and mathematics
